 The French authorities unilaterally purport to exercise jurisdiction (which is not recognised by the Government of Mauritius) over Tromelin and its waters; and

(ii) The UK Government unilaterally purports to exercise jurisdiction (which is not recognised by the Government of Mauritius) over the Chagos Archipelago and its waters.

The issue of this licence does not relieve the vessel from the obligation to comply with any other enactment in force in Mauritius.
