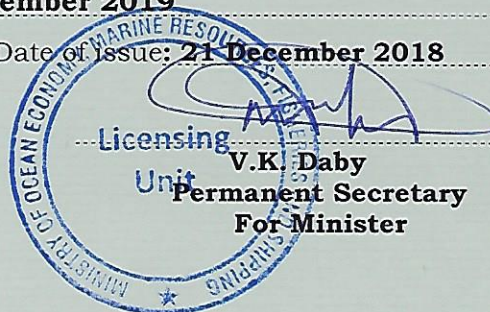

NOTE:

1. (a) There exist disputes between:
 - (i) Mauritius and France concerning Tromelin and its surrounding waters (including its EEZ); and
 - (ii) Mauritius and the UK concerning the Chagos Archipelago and its surrounding waters (including its EEZ);
 (b) While Mauritius unequivocally asserts its sovereignty over Tromelin and the Chagos Archipelago and their waters (including their EEZ):
 - (i) The French authorities unilaterally purport to exercise jurisdiction (which is not recognised by the Government of Mauritius) over Tromelin and its waters; and
 - (ii) The UK Government unilaterally purports to exercise jurisdiction (which is not recognised by the Government of Mauritius) over the Chagos Archipelago and its waters.
2. The issue of this licence does not relieve the vessel from the obligation to comply with any other enactment in force in Mauritius.
